The Summer Programme will be a varied range of activities focused on **music, drama, science, art and sport**. The programme will be run by the current creative and inspiring PH academic team.

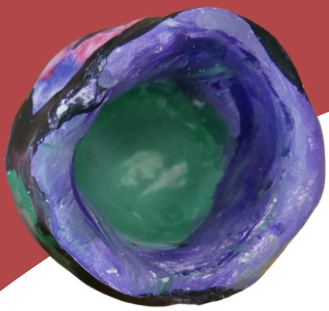

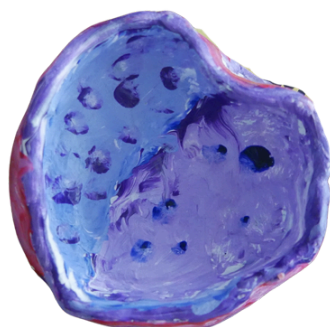
Children will take part in a fun, structured programme that includes:

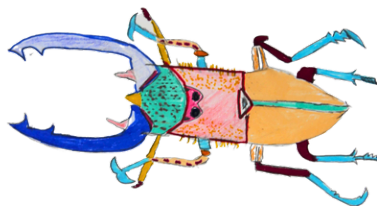
What to wear
